



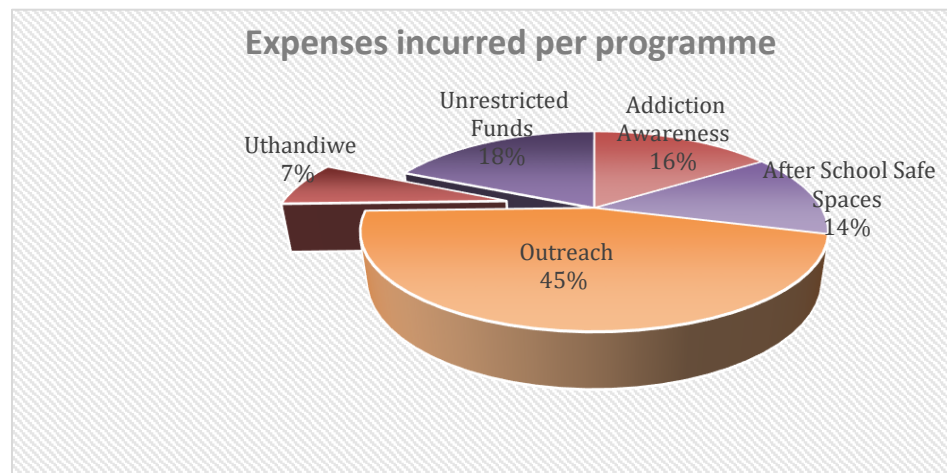
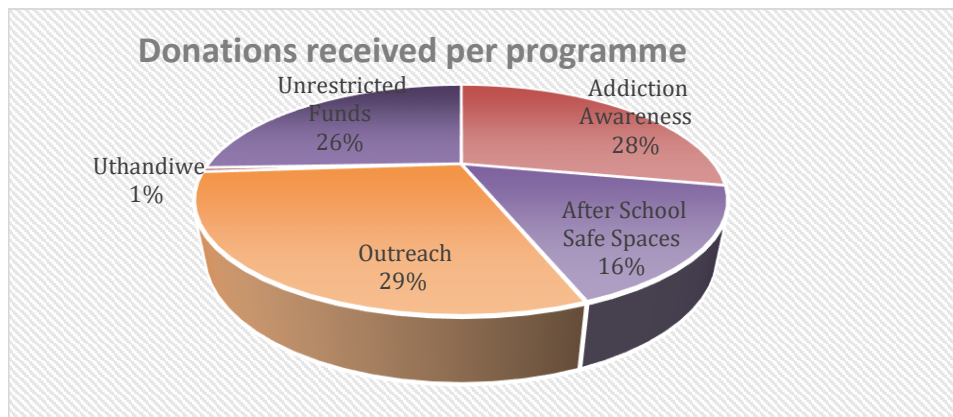
# MASAKHE NEWS

Many organisations in the charitable space struggled during the past two years as the COVID19 pandemic placed extra strain on the finances of most donors. We were no exception and also felt the “pain” as many of our regular donors found it difficult to continue to their support us. We had to think outside the box and with the help of the leadership of the New Apostolic Church SA (who assisted us with advertising), new donors came on board.



During our Financial year, which ended in February 2022, we could resume with our Addiction Awareness Facilitator training course - we opened 3 hubs; we reopened our After School Safe Spaces hub in Leiden – hosting 120 learners daily and we could provide food relief to 4200 families.
